

# PART I

2002 - 2009

**K**ensington Community Fellowship Church started out as a plant out from Central Community Fellowship by Pastor Morgan and Valencia Pillay under the direction and supervision of Pastor Ivor and Hilary Temlett.

Pastor Morgan and Valencia Pillay became cell leaders in 1993, appointed as Zone Supervisors in 1995 and were called to full-time ministry in 1999. They then served under Pastor Ivor for three years before the church multiplied.

KCF held its first service at the Kensington Secondary School on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2002. *Pastor Ivor would share his experience of the plant out: "They had an incredible job to do. They had to set up a church from scratch which meant they needed to find a building to have church in. They needed to get sound and musical equipment. They had to find a worship group and teachers for the children's ministry. They had to find youth leaders and cell leaders. They were starting from scratch with nothing."*

Our stay at the school was from July to December 2002. Thereafter we moved to the Hellenic church on the corner of 7<sup>th</sup> Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Bezuidenhout Valley.

Our first service here was held on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2002.

God's word to us in 2002 was from Genesis 12:2 "**...I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing**" and the vision is: *To evangelize our communities and establish churches by planting, growing and multiplying impact groups.*

## KCF DEPARTMENTS

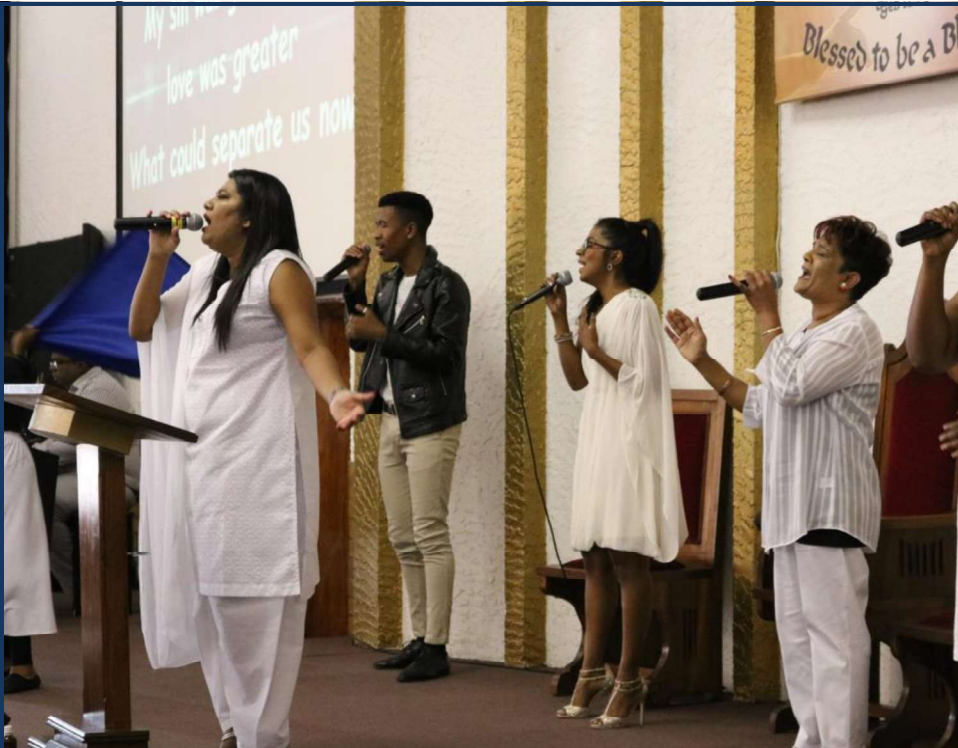

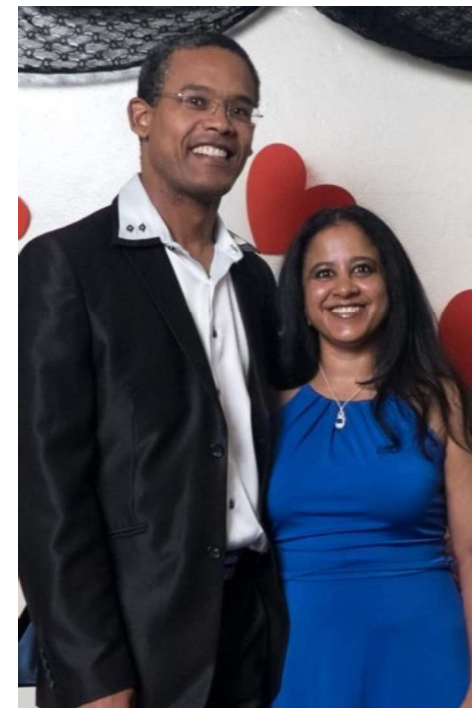
## K4L JOURNEY

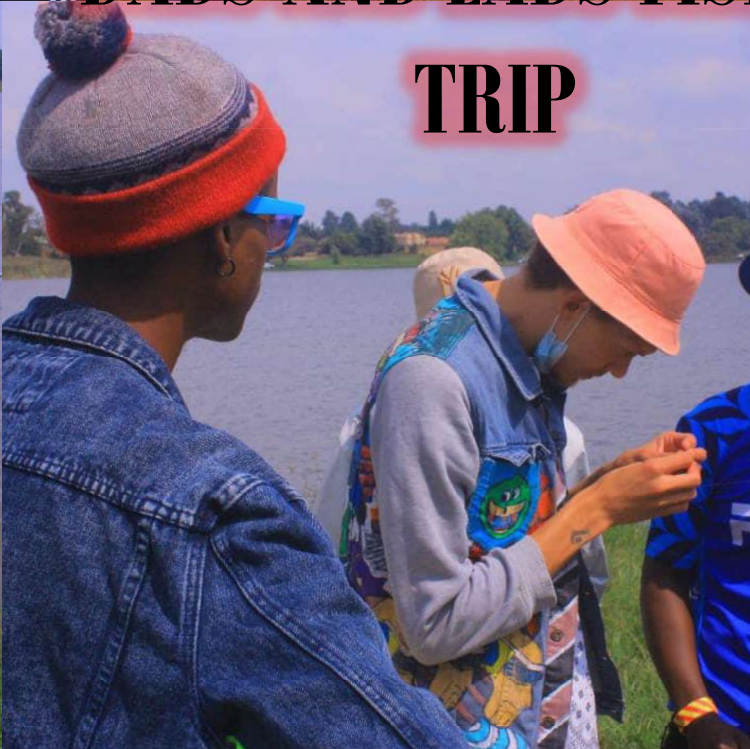
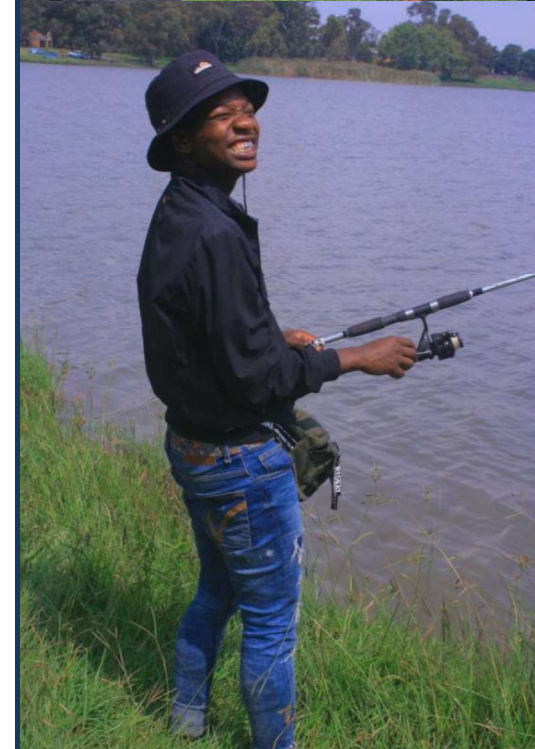

The team is focused on bridging generation gaps, so that these young people can seamlessly grow into leadership roles within the church and be a positive influence in the community.









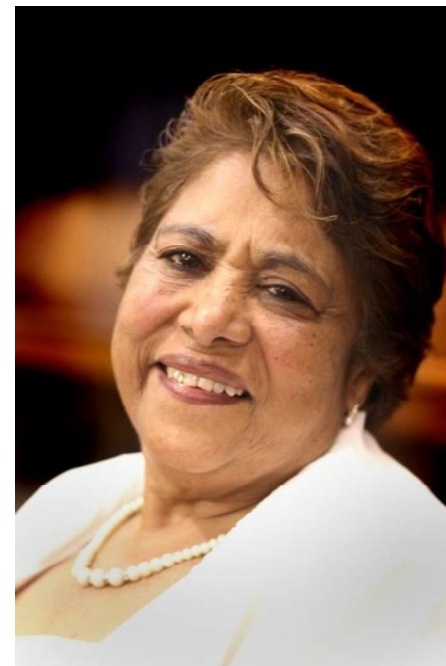
## INTERCESSION
