MULTIPLYING

Our church was growing at a steady rate which meant that we needed to go into two services. We were still renting the building and needed to negotiate with the Hellenics to move their service times to accommodate us. They refused to budge and so we decided to have a 7am service. Their refusal to sell the building and the ongoing challenges with the rented property led us to look for alternate premises to buy or rent.

It was during this time that we found a 160-seater church in Troyeville for sale. This church was obviously too small for KCF but Pastor Morgan felt led to buy this church for *Divine Fountain Church* to use. He presented this proposal to the KCF board. The board agreed and the church was purchased for Pastors Musa and Angel who are still using it to this day.



Two years after the purchase of the church in Troyeville, four things happened that can only be called blessings from God.

1. The church grew by 20%.

The congregation grew and many people were becoming members of the church.

2. The church's finances increased.

We were blessed with finances that also assisted in buying equipment and resources for the church.

3. The purchase of the Hellenic church.

Due to financial crisis in Greece, the Hellenics sold the building to us and so we now had a church building that we could call our own.

4. Emmanuel Home.

In May 2014 Mrs. Ivy Hammond donated the Emmanuel Homes building in Bertrams to KCF church.

WASP Community Services was a vision that Pastor Morgan had to provide support to widows and single parents. It was first led by Suren Krishna, Lee-Anne Reddy, Kevin and Krishnie Pillay.



The organization was registered as an NPO with PBO status on 23 February 2012 and operates from and is affiliated to Kensington Community Fellowship. Currently the organization is involved in the monthly and annual distribution of grocery parcels to the poor and needy. WASP is a 100% volunteer-based organization.

Our mission is to provide support to pensioners, widows, orphans, street people and to those infected with and affected by HIV/AIDS.

Our vision is to establish a culture of a “self-sustaining community” who is equipped to uplift their living conditions and be able to manage their lives, passing it forward to the next generation, by offering the community life skills programs and availing counsellors and life coaches to give the community the building blocks to start this journey and the necessary support along the way.

The current board that oversees WASP is made up of Pastor Morgan Pillay, Pastor Musa Makamu, Pastor Strini Marimuthoo, Lee-Anne Reddy, Charles Essaram and Lucy Barnabas together with a host of volunteers.

TOEKOMSRUS OUTREACH

The Toekomsrus Community project in August 2014 started when Pastor Morgan visited the area. His heart was burdened as the community did not have a proper place of worship. He made it his goal to help this community in any way he can. He made a call to the members of KCF and was faced with the challenge of setting up a church in one day. It was no easy task as a lot of things were being taken into consideration. In one day the members had to put up a tent, paint the entire fence around the property, put up new sign boards, build a stage, set up musical instruments and also redecorate the crèche area.

After the entire church was set up, they now had to go out into the community and invite people to the church service that was happening that same day. The mission was accomplished as many people were amazed and blessed with having a proper venue to have church.



BIBLE SCHOOL

The Kensington Community Fellowship Bible School commenced in 2011 with Pastor Morgan as the Dean. Our first graduation was held on 31 March 2012 with 10 students graduating with certificates and 1 student with a diploma.

Our second graduation was held on 29 March 2014 with 12 students graduating with certificates, 12 students graduating with diplomas and one student graduating with a degree.

Our third graduation was held on 8 March 2015 with 7 students graduating with certificates and 7 students graduating with diplomas. In June 2016, 3 students graduated with certificates, 8 with diplomas and 7 with degrees.
